Plan to spend the day either bringing lunch

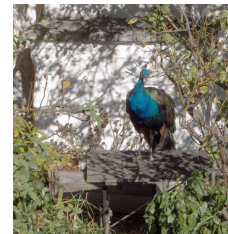
or you can eat at the cafe where food is great, but service often slow.

We should be starting to see Autumn colour at this time of year and there are plenty of undercover spots if the weather is inclement.

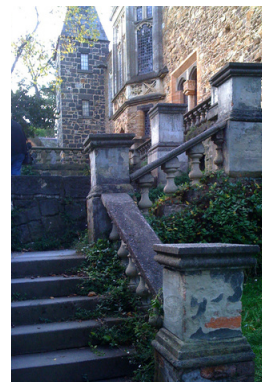


Bring art materials and a stool to use if you need to sit, although there are many places where you can perch.
